**PROGRESSIVE** He or She keeps his or her station up to date. It is

well-built and efficient. His or Her operating

practice is above reproach.

**FRIENDLY** He or She operates slowly and patiently when

requested; offers friendly advice and counsel to beginners; kind assistance, cooperation and

consideration for the interests of others. These are

the marks of the amateur spirit.

**BALANCED** Radio is a hobby, never interfering with duties owed

to family, job, school or community.

**PATRIOTIC** His or Her station and skills are always ready for

service to country and community.
