Ham Holiday 2022 is "in-the-books" and it was another great event. This year the Oklahoma City hamfest was held in person at Oklahoma City Community College after a two-year hiatus. The OKC hamfest has been held since 1974 in the Oklahoma City area. A hamfest is a place for amateur radio operators to meet and greet their fellow hams, buy and sell their radio equipment, learn some new operating modes or upcoming activities, and just have fun.

On Friday, the hamfest operated from 3:00 pm to 7:00 pm and was followed by a banquet that featured our ARRL West Gulf Division Director John Stratton N5AUS. John gave us an update on the information from the most recent ARRL board of directors meeting, HOA legislation, congressional involvement, current issues in the amateur radio community, and future plans of the ARRL,

The flea market tables were filled with goodies of all sizes and shapes. Everything from microphones, to radios and amplifiers, were displayed and were available for sale. Associated Radio, Derby Radio Shack, and Lee Rhode had their commercial wares available for sale.

Educational forums were offered on ARRL/ARES activities, Winlink, AREDN Mesh Network, Parks On the Air (POTA), AUXCOM, YLs, antenna building kits, and the Oklahoma DX Association were mostly standing room only.

Raffles offered attendees many prize-winning opportunities throughout the weekend. The winner of the grand prize Yaesu FTDX10 radio was Coy Day N5OK. This year there was an extra raffle that gave us a chance, for \$20, to win a deluxe ICOM 705 package that included the automatic antenna tuner, external case parts, an external display, and other goodies. Steve Duskin NE5SD walked away with that great radio package with a HUGE smile on his face.

The SCARS VE Team held an exam session that netted new technicians and a new general.
