GREEN COUNTRY HAMFEST 2025: By Merlin Griffin - WB5OSM

Registration for the Green Country Hamfest 2025 is now open

at http://greencountryhamfest.org. Admission and table prices are same as last year. As of the writing of this article, we have 142 flea market tables left.

1st Prize Yaesu FT-710 AESS SDR HF - 6 meter all mode 100 watt transceiver, includes an external speaker.

2nd Prize Yaesu FT-991A all mode transceiver covers HF-6 M + 2M and 70 CM. Power reduced for digital modes, AM & FM. It's small enough to use it mobile.

3rd Prize Yaesu FT 891A, mobile/portable HF rig.

A FT-4R Dual band HT will be given away as an hourly prize during much of the show. Two RF Shark Open Spot 2.0 devices will be given away, one on Friday and one on Saturday. These devices solve some of the problems of the digital voice modes. They can convert DMR to Fusion, Fusion to D-Star, D-Star to DMR, etc.
