**Engineering:** Chairman Joe N5TEX reported all repeaters ok. Tom K5OVT reported that the Tulsa South DMR repeater is off the air for relocation from Autumn Oaks to provide better coverage of Broken Arrow. Another DMR repeater at Autumn Oaks is on another network, and Tom is checking its capabilities. Ben Joplin asked a question about DNS attacks affecting digital ham radio systems on the Internet. Tony White, KA5TRO mentioned that DMR does not use DNS very much, and pointed out a workaround is available. Mark Conklin, N7XYO mentioned a new repeater going up in Henryetta on 10 NOV 2016.

**Public Relations:** Chairman Doug Lee, KC5ZQM, reported no PR events until spring. Wagoner County Expo is in late March, and he will set up a small display there.
