## 146.88 REPAIRS:

On Saturday October 12<sup>th</sup> a small group (Bob - W5RAB, Joe - N5TEX, Merlin - WB5OSM, and myself WB5ANX) went to the 28/88 site to do some repairs. With reports of signal quality not what it should be we went to find out why. We found several things; the antenna listing at 10 degrees, an N connector issue, but the big issue was the Henry Power Amp was offline with a blown fuse.

In the pics you can see some of the work done. On the roof the RF environment is so intense we are required to wear an RF Suit...that provides a shield to the RF. In the background of the pic you can see a big red antenna...that is one of three commercial TV broadcast antennas up there. Ours is the DB224.

All in all it took about 5 hrs of work. We straightened up the antenna, got the PA working at about 65 watts on the antenna side of the cans, and Merlin made a few adjustments to the controller announcements. We would appreciate your signal reports as you move around Tulsa and our community.
