
## **GREEN COUNTRY HAMFEST 2022:**

### **ENGINEERING REPORT:**

Here is a quick update on the 146.88 repeater and City Plex site.

Merlin – WB5OSM and I - N5TEX met there last Saturday to find the entire City Plex complex without commercial power. They were running on generator power and our site is not on that feed. Our equipment is not on emergency or back up power. So we could not troubleshoot the equipment.

Tuesday this week I went back up to the site to find none of the 88 equipment or 900mhz powered on. I rebooted the 900 MHz equipment and it came back on line, it is ac powered.

The 88 system was totally off with no dc power. I found the 40amp fuse in the MFJ power distribution had a broken blade. After removing the defective fuse and replacing it with a 35 amp fuse the 88 equipment came on. Shortly after the dc power came on as I was looking at the equipment faces smoke started coming from the MFJ 1124 power distribution outlet. The 35 amp fuse plastic was melting. I quickly pulled it out and shut of the ac power to the rack except for the 900mhz equipment which is still working. I also pulled the dc power leads from the power supply. Not sure what piece of equipment is drawing so much power, the MFJ power panel may need to be replaced. The circuit board looked fried.

We need to take and disassemble the power panel to see how much damage is done and to see if it is repairable or not. Find out what is drawing so much power. It may be best to get another power panel and split the load. I did measure the voltage output of the power supply it was 13.74volts. The 900 rx was kicking in intermittently most likely rf noise from the roof.
