CHANGE OF A TRO BY-LAW:

A motion was made at the September 23, 2025 meeting to change the By-Law Section V - Officers 5.02 President.

Motion is to strike "not serve more than two (2) consecutive terms" from the by-law. The new by-law would be:

5.02 President

The President shall preside at all meetings of the Club membership and the Executive Committee. The President shall be an ex-officio member of all the other Club Committees. The President must sign all authorized contracts and other obligations and undertakings in the name of and on behalf of the Club. The President shall appoint by December 1 a Nominating Committee to nominate officers for the coming year. The President shall be the principal officer of the Club and shall have general charge and supervision of the Club's affairs and shall perform such other duties as may from time to time be assigned to the President by the Executive Committee. The President shall have been a member for at least three (3) years prior to election to the position.

Need by-laws committee approval and publish in the Signal newsletter then a vote of a membership quorum.

At the TRO/Tulsa Red Cross VE Testing Session on 9/18/25. We produced two new Technician Class licensees.

Mr. Juan Jackson of Tulsa and Mr. Boyd Anderson of Broken Arrow.

We had four actual candidates and two were not successful, one retested, but still didn't pass. Hopefully with a little more study, they will make it on their next attempt.

The VE Team was Tom Shelton K5OHM, Curtiss Looper N5CEL and Merlin Griffin WB5OSM. Our next session will be 11/20/2025 at the Red Cross.

Currently the FCC is not issuing new licenses due to the partial government shutdown. I doubt they are doing renewals either.

The ARRL-VEC announced that they will no longer be printing exam booklets. July 1, 2026, the Technician test will start using the new question pool. VE teams may print test booklets using exam generating software, or administer the entire session electronically. We can arrange for applicants to use their smart devices, or provide tablets for the applicants to use.
